to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the consolidated fund of the State of Arunachal Pradesh for the services of a part of the financial year 2025-2026.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Arunachal Pradesh in the Seventy-Sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

| 1. (1) This Act may be called the Arunachal Pradesh Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2025. | Short title. |
| (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1st April, 2025 and same shall be in force for the whole financial year 2025-26 ending 31st March, 2026. | |
| 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Arunachal Pradesh there may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Rupees Thirty nine thousand eight hundred forty two crore twenty three lakh only towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year, 2025-26 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule. | Withdrawal of
