NOTIFICATION

No. DES-11027/1/2021-DSE-ED/443.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules to regulate the marking scheme for Direct Recruitment to the posts of Post Graduate Teacher(s) (PGTs) (Group – B Gazetted) and Trained Graduate Teacher(s) (TGTs) (Group – B Non-Gazetted), under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, namely:-

- 1. **Short title and commencement:** (1) These rules may be called "Marking Scheme for Direct Recruitment to the posts of Post Gradute Teacher(s) (PGTs) and Trained Graduate Teacher(s) (TGTs), Rules, 2025".
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Arunachal Pradesh Gazette.
- Marking Scheme for Direct Recruitment to the posts of Post Graduate Teacher(s) (PGTs) (Group – B Gazetted) and Trained Graduate Teacher(s) (TGTs) (Group – B Non-Gazetted), Rules, 2025.

- 3. In case the number of applicants is more than the requisite ratio for the written examination for the post of PGTs or TGTs as the case may be, then the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (APPSC) may conduct a Recruitment Test/Preliminary Examination in order to select candidates for appearing in the final written examination.
- 4. The Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (APPSC) shall prepare question papers according to the syllabus provided by the Department for conducting examination for recruitment of Post Graduate Teachers (PGTs) and Trained Graduate Teachers (TGTs) posts and publish the same along with the Advertisement.

- 5. The Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (APPSC) shall also finalize the syllabus and exam pattern of Recruitment Test as mentioned at para 3 above (if required) and publish the same well in advance.
- 6. The Minimum Educational Qualifications shall be in accordance with the existing Recruitment Rules i.e. for direct recruit to PGT (column 8 of recruitment rules) states "Master Degree with 2nd Class in the concerned subject from a recognized university with B.Ed" and "The Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) recruitment Rules, 2008" in column 8 mentions "Bachelor Degree in Arts/Science/Commerce with 2nd Class in concerned subject from a recognized university with B.Ed".
- 7. Amendment of Recruitment Rules/Service Rules: All (i) Service Rules/Recruitment Rules/Guidelines regulating the Examination Scheme for the posts of PGTs and TGTs shall be deemed to have been amended to the extent provided herein above with immediate effect.
- 8. **Power to amend the Rules :** The State Government shall have the powers to alter, modify, amend, rescind or supersede these rules from time to time as may be deemed necessary and expedient so to do.
- 9. Power to Relax: Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for the reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts.
- 10. **Interpretation :** If any question arises as to the interpretation of these rules, the same shall be decided by the State Government which shall be final and binding.
