### THE ARUNACHAL PRADESH FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY AND BUDGET MANAGEMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2026

(Act No. 6 of 2026)

further to amend the Arunachal Pradesh Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act, 2006 (Act No. 6 of 2006).

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Arunachal Pradesh in the Seventy-Seventh year of the Republic of India as follows:

1. **Short title and commencement** : (1) This Act may be called the Arunachal Pradesh Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management (Amendment) Act, 2026.

(2) It shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 2026.

2. **Amendment of Section 4** : In the Arunachal Pradesh Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), in Section 4, in sub-section (3), after clause (l), the following clause shall be added:-

“(m) the fiscal deficit of the State Government for the financial years, 2026-27 to 2030-31 shall continue to be capped at 3 percent of Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) (excluding loans under SASCI) and this should be strictly enforced in accordance with clause(3) of Article 293 of the Constitution.”
