No. DPR/100/2025/295.— In exercise of power conferred by sub-section (3) of Section 122 of the Arunachal Pradesh Panchayati Raj Act, 1997 (Act No. 5 of 2001) and approval of the Gauhati High Court as conveyed vide letter No. HC.VII-03/2026/391/A dated 27th January, 2026, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to constitute a one Member Panchayati Raj Election Tribunal.

Further, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to appoint **Dr. Hirendra Kashyap, District and Session Judge, Yupia** as Member of the Tribunal with the following terms and conditions :

1. The member shall hold office from the date of assuming charge of the Panchayati Raj Election Tribunal.
2. The member shall be provided with a Government vehicle befitting the status of District and Session Judge with a driver plus 200 litres of petrol per month.

The member shall also be entitled to T.A and D.A as per Guwahati High Court Rules.

3. The State Government shall provide such officers and employees necessary to the Panchayati Raj Election Tribunal.
4. The member shall be provided with contingent staff to perform the duties of bungalow peon and typist as per standard Government norms.
5. The State Government shall bear the mailing charges for all official communication.
6. The tenure of office shall be co-terminus with the election dispute cases.
