DECLARATION

The 30th March, 2026

(Under Section (19) of the Right of Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013).

No. LMD-13011(11)/3/2024/2187.—**WHEREAS**, it appears to the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh that a total 0.2 Hectares (2023.428 Sqmtr) of land is required at **Baja Gigi** in Baja Gigi Village under **Gepen Circle, Kamle District** for public purposes namely **Establishment of Communication Infrastructure Node for Signal Communication**.

AND WHEREAS, a preliminary notification as required under Section 11 of LARR Act, 2013 was issued by the Department of Land Management vide No. **LMD-13011(11)/3/2024/63** dated **Itanagar, the 12th December, 2025**, notifying the intention of the State Government for acquiring of **0.2 Hectares (2023.428 Sqmtr)** of the said land and inviting public claims and objections to the proposed acquisition of land if any.

AND WHEREAS, the Deputy Commissioner, **Kamle District**, vide his Memo No. **DC/KAM/LM- 385/2021/3448-55 Dated Raga, the 24th December, 2025**, certified that land is a private land and free from public and Government projects and that there are no project affected families and therefore no compensation towards Rehabilitation and Resettlement of public of Village are required to be paid under Section 31 of the LARR Act and has requested the State Government to issue the draft declaration under Section 19 of the LARR Act, 2013.

AND WHEREAS, the Appropriate Government is pleased to note that it is satisfied that Chapters - II and III and Section - 15 and 16 shall not apply to acquisition process in respect of the said land at **Baja Gigi Village for Establishment of Communication Infrastructure Node for Signal Communication under Gepen Circle of Kamle District**.

AND NOW, therefore the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to issue the Declaration under Section 19 of the Act specifying that the piece of land measuring **0.2 Hectare (2023. 428 Sqmtr)** located at **Baja Gigi Village in Baja Gigi Village under Gepen Circle, Kamle District** is being acquired, the detailed description whereof is as follows:-

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is further pleased to order as under:-

- (i) The except such parts of the mines and minerals which may be required to be dug or removed or used during construction phase of the project for the purpose of which land is being acquired, no mines, minerals, iron, stone, slate and other minerals lying under the said land shall be extracted or removed.
- (ii) A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Collector and DLRSO, Kamle District on any working day during the working hours. The provisions of the chapter-II and III and Section 15 to 18 of the Act shall not apply to the acquisition in respect of the above land since the land is acquired by the ministry of Defense in exercise of the powers conferred by sub- section (1) and (4) of Section 40 of the LARR Act, 2013.
- (iii) The Collector (Deputy Commissioner) through no award has been made, may, on expiration of thirty days from the date of publication of the notice mentioned in Section 21, take possession of any land needed for a public purpose and such land shall thereupon vest absolutely in the Government free from all encumbrances.
- (iv) No additional compensation will be paid as per Section 40(5) of the LARR Act, 2013 since the acquisition affects the sovereignty and integrity of India and the security and strategic interest of the State.
