DECLARATION

The 19th February, 2026

(Under Section 19 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013)

No. LMD-13011/17/2025/1607.— **WHEREAS**, it appears to the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh that a total area of **6.570 Hectares (65700 Sq mtrs)** of land is required at **Jairampur Nampong Area** under Jairampur Sub-Division of Changlang District, Arunachal Pradesh for public purposes, namely for **Erection of Fence and Construction of Track Road along Fence along Indo- Myanmar Border (IMB) between BP-172 to BP-173 (Total Length 7.300 KM)** by the Border Roads Organization, 103-RCC (GREF), C/o 99APO.

AND WHEREAS, a preliminary notification as required under Section 11 Read with Section 40(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resttlement Act, 2013 was issued by the Department of Land Management vide Memo No. LMD-13011/17/2025/900 dated Itanagar, the 30th July, 2025 notifying the intention of the State Government for acquiring of 6.570 Hectares (65700 Sq.mtrs) of the said land and inviting public claims and objections to the proposed aquisition of land any.

AND WHEREAS, the Deputy Commissioner, Changlang District, vide his Memo No. C/LR/LA-IMB (BP-172 to 173)/25 dated Changlang, the 3rd February, 2026 certified that land is private land (except RF area and any other Government land) and free from public and Government projects and that there are no project affected famillies and therefore no compensation towards Rehabilitation and Resstlement are required to be paid under Section 31 of LARR Act and has requested the State Government to issue the draft declarartion under Section 19 of the LARR Act, 2013.

AND, WHEREAS, the Appropriate Government is pleased to note that it is satisfied that Chapters-II and III and Section 15 and 16 shall not apply to acquisition process in respect of the said land at Jairampur Nampong Area under Jairampur Sub-Division of Changlang District, Arunachal Pradesh for public purposes, namely for **“Erection of Fence and Construction of Track Road along Fence along Indo-Myanmar Border (IMB) between BP-172 to BP-173 (Total Length-7.300 KM)”**.

AND NOW, therefore the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to issue the Declaration under Section 19 of the Act specifying that the piece of the measuring 6.570 Hectares (65700 Sq.mtrs) at Jairampur Nampong Area under Jairampur Sub-Division of Changlang District, Arunachal Pradesh for public purposes, namely for **“Erection of Fence and Construction of Track Road along Fence along Indo- Myanmar Border (IMB) between BP-172 to BP-173 (Total Length-7.300 KM)”** by the Border Roads Organisation, 103-RCC (GREF), C/o 99APO is being acquired.
