DECLARATION

The 15th January, 2026

(Declaration Under Section 19(1) Read with Section 40(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (Act 30 of 2023))

No. LMD-13011(11)/20/2025/212.—**WHEREAS**, the Appropriate Government is satisfied that the land specified in the Schedule below is needed for a purpose, namely, up-gradation of Kimin-Potin Road from NHSL specification to NHDL Specification from Ch: 20.00 KM to 35.500 KM by 119 RCC (GREF), under Kimin Circle, Papum Pare District, Arunachal Pradesh.

AND WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Appropriate Government, the matter is one of the defense importance road being international border state which necessitates the immediate acquisition of the said land.

AND WHEREAS, the declaration is issued under Section 19(1) read with Section 40(1) of the Act, stating the land in the Schedule is required for the public purpose. Additionally, under Section 40(1) of the Act, the Appropriate Government directs that Chapters-II and III are not applicable due to urgency.

NOW THEREFORE, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to issue the Declaration Section 19(1) read with Section 40(1) of the Act specifying that the piece of land as mentioned in the schedule below is being acquired.

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is further pleased to order as under:-

- (i) Except such parts of the mines and minerals which may be required to be dug or removed or used during construction phase of the project for the purpose of which land is being acquired, no mines, minerals, iron, stone, slate and other minerals lying under the said land shall be extracted or removed.
- (ii) A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Collector and DLRSO, Papum Pare District on any working day during the working hours. The provisions of the Chapter-II and III and Section 15 to 18 of the Act shall not apply to the acquisition in respect of the above land since the land is acquired by the Ministry of Defence in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) and (4) of Section 40 of the LARR Act, 2013.
- (iii) The Collector (Deputy Commissioner) through no award has been made, may, on expiration of thirty days from the date of publication of the notice mentioned in Section 21, take possession of any land needed for a public purpose and such land shall thereupon vest absolutely in the Government free from all encumbrances.
- (iv) No additional compensation will be paid as per Section 40(5) of the LARR Act, 2013 since the acquisition affects the sovereignty and integrity of India and the security and strategic interest of the State.
