DECLARATION

The 19th March, 2026,

(Under Section 19 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013)

No. LMD-13011(14)/10/2025/1948.—**WHEREAS**, it appears to the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh that a total of **0.0982 Hectares (982 Sqmtr)** of land is required at **Muri - Mugli Village** under **Puchigeko Circle, Kamle District** for public purposes namely **Construction of Approach Road towards proposed 33/11kV Muri - Mugli Sub-Station at Muri- Mugli Village.**

AND WHEREAS, a preliminary notification as required under Section 11 of LARR Act, 2013 was issued by the **Power Grid has sent a requisition** vide letter No. **NER/APCOMP/Daporijo/501/812 dated 24th May**, notifying the intention of the State Government for acquiring of **0.0982 Hectares (982 Sqmtr)** of the said land and inviting public claims and objection to the proposed acquisition of land if any.

AND WHEREAS, the Deputy Commissioner, **Kamle District**, vide his Memo No. **DC/KAM/LM-418/2021/2961-69 dated Raga, the 29th October, 2025**, certified that land is a private land and free from public and Government project and that there are no project affected families and therefore no compensation towards Rehabilitation and Resettlement of public of village are required to be paid under Section 31 of the LARR Act, and has requested that State Government to issue the draft declaration under Section 19 of LARR Act, 2013.

AND WHEREAS, the Appropriate Government is pleased to note that it is satisfied that Chapter-II and III and Section- 15 & 16 Shall not apply to acquisition process in respect of the said land at **Muri - Mugli Village for the Construction of Approach Road towards proposed 33/11 kV Muri - Mugli Sub-Station at Muri - Mugli Village under Puchigeko Circle of the Kamle District.**

AND NOW, therefore the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to issue the Declaration under Section 19 of the Act specifying that the piece of land measuring **0.0982 Hectares (982 Sqmtr)** located at **Muri - Mugli Village** under **Puchigeko Circle, Kamle District** is being acquired, the detailed description whereof is as follows : -
