## NOTIFICATION

No. CLMCA-13013/01/2026/05.—The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in its order dated May 21, 2025 passed in Civil Appeal No. 9982 of 2024 arising out of SLP@ No. 25612 of 2023, in the matter of Ganesh Kumar Rajeshwar Rao Selukar and Anr Vs Mahendra Bhaskar Limaye and Ors and other connected matters, had in Para 102 issued a set of directions governing the functioning, appointment and continuity of Members of the Consumer Disputes Redressal Commissions:

Now, therefore, in compliance with said directions, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to notify that the following Members of the State and District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission shall continue as such members on an interim basis, notwithstanding the expiry of their respective tenure, until the completion of the said recruitment process in accordance with law.
