ORDER

The 8th May, 2026

1. **WHEREAS**, an application vide No. SIC/VIG/PRO-SAN/17/2020 dated Itanagar the 15th of May, 2025, has been received from Inspector Inya Ete, SIC (VIG) PS, Itanagar, who is the Investigating Officer of SIC (VIG) PS Case No. 14/2018 U/S 409/420/201/506/120 (B) IPC R/W Sec 13 (1) (c) (d) & 13 (2) PC Act 1988, for according sanction to prosecute 1. Smty Kipa Kaku then Chief Councillor IMC, Naharlagun, 2. Shri Dacha Bagang, Town Planner, the then former Assistant Town Planner cum Municipal Secretary, Itanagar Municipal Council, 3. Shri Baba Bagang then AE IMC Naharlagun and 4. Shri Karling Tech Tara then JE IMC Naharlagun in the Court of Law under the provision of Section 197 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and Section 19 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.
2. **AND WHEREAS**, A complaint letter was submitted by Unemployed All Arunachal Engineers Association (UAAEA), based on which the government sought a report from DC/ICC in the said matter. Subsequently, in pursuance to the DC Order No. IMC/ADMIN/Mis-01/2018/1337 Dated 20th July, 2018 a discrete enquiry was connected to the alleged illegal appointments of various posts Of JES/UDCS/LDCs/Sanitary Assistants and Unskilled Contingency Staff in IMC, Naharlagun office, was conducted by Shri Hengo Basar, EAC, IMC, Naharlagun and Shri Toko Babu, EAC (Jud.), Itanagar Capital Complex and the enquiry report was submitted. Based on the enquiry report, the instant case has been registered after seeking due permission from the competent authority.
3. **AND WHEREAS**, the enquiry report which was forwarded by DC, Itanagar Capital Complex, has revealed the following points :

Gross Irregularities and procedural lapses amounting to serious criminal misconduct by hatching a criminal conspiracy for inflicting wrongful loss to the government exchequer, were observed in the appointment to the above mentioned posts in Itanagar Municipal council in contravention of Section 36(4), (5) and (8) of Arunachal Pradesh Municipal Act, 2007 and various recruitment rules as practiced generally in the state of Arunachal Pradesh by the accused officers namely Shri Olik Taring, then CMEO/IMC, Shri Dacha Bagang the then Assistant Town Planner Cum Municipal Secretary, Smti Kipa Kaku, Former Chief Councillor, Shri Baba Bagang, AE, IMC and Shri Chakpu Raju, AE-IMC This act of gross criminal misconduct has been done in blatant violation of rules and procedures in practice.
4. **AND WHEREAS**, the enquiry report by Shri Toko Babu, then EAC (Jud), O/O the DC, Itanagar Capital Complex and Shri Hengo Basar, the then EAC, IMC, Naharlagun and EAC, O/O the DC, Itanagar Capital Complex had further revealed that all the relevant case files pertaining to appointments to the above mentioned posts are missing from IMC records and are apparently in the custody of the accused officers. This act shows clear malafide intention on the part of the accused officers to conceal the said documents from the government, thereby implying malafide intent in conspiracy with one another. Further, there is a very high likelihood of tampering with evidence as the relevant files are still in the custody of the accused officers.
5. **AND WHEREAS**, the enquiry report has also revealed payment of salaries to some of the appointed government, officers which implies loss to the government, exchequer due to the illegal appointments made by the accused officers through misuse and abuse of powers entrusted to them in their official capacity in connivance with each other. This act of criminal misconduct of the accused officers has led to wrongful loss to the government, exchequer.
6. Besides the procedural lapses revealed during the enquiry, an undue and inexplicable haste has also been noticed in issuing of appointment orders for MJES/LDC/UDCs etc. which goes to show that the actions of the alleged accused persons namely Shri Olik Taring, then CMEO/IMC, Shri Dacha Bagang, Asst Town Planner Cum Municipal Secretary, Smti Kipa Kaku Former Chief Councillor, Shri Baba Bagang, AE, IMC and Chakpu Raju AE-IMC were totally malafide and were done with ulterior motive.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the perusal of documents and the enquiry report clearly reveal that the above mentioned accused conspired with each other to cause wrongful loss to the Government exchequer and defrauded the government by abusing the powers entrusted to them in their official capacity.
8. **WHEREAS**, it is revealed that a total of 139 appointees of LDC/UDCs and 74 JEs were being provided training in Kamrup College of Vocational Training and Rocket Science Services respectively. In both these institutes, Back-dated MoUs have been signed by Shri Dacha Bagang on behalf of IMC in the presence of Shri Nitesh as witness. It has also been unearthed that a total of ₹ 5 lakhs in 2 cash installments and ₹ 7 lakhs 33 thousand in 2 cash instalments were given to KCVT and Rocket Science Service respectively. Statement u/s 164 Cr PC of Shri Devaroon Bharali, Principal KCVT has been recorded and Statement u/s 161 CrPC of Shri Debendra Nath Das, Director Rocket science services has been recorded in this regard. Further original MoUs, attendance records, Money Receipts etc. have been seized to corroborate the statements.
9. **WHEREAS**, the institute KCVT is in existence since last 63 years in Guwahati. Shri Bhorali had no prior acquaintance with accused Nitesh. Nitesh had enquired about the training schedule and fees structure etc. from the institution through email to which Shri Bhorali responded in a normal course of business. Thereafter, It was Nitesh Kumar who brought accused Shri Dacha Bagang and introduced Bagang as Secretary of Itanagar Municipal Council. Taking the plea of requirement of official formalities, Shri Dacha Bagang convinced the principal to execute a MoU on a back date i.e. 11th June, 2018 whereas the MoU was executed practically on 21st July, 2018. Considering the training of trainees and their fresh appointments as UDC/ LDC in IMC, Sri Bhorali agreed and executed the back dated MOU.
10. **WHEREAS**, the training duration for UDC/LDC was for 03 months for the purpose of which the training fess was ₹ 10 thousand per trainee. On 1st August, 2018, trainees were admitted in the institution for the training wef 2nd August, 2018. A total of 136 trainees were admitted in the institution. Payment of the training fees of ₹ 10,000/- was done in respect of 50 trainees only. Hence, a batch of 21 trainees sent back by the KCVT. It has also been revealed that Shri Dacha Bagang informed the principal that Nitesh will make all fresh correspondence on his behalf. Subsequently Nitesh made a payment for 50 students of ₹ 5 lakhs in cash installments on behalf of IMC.
11. **WHEREAS**, Shri Dacha Bagang was the Asstt. Town Planner cum Secretary, Itanagar Municipal Council, Itanagar. He along with Shri Baba Bagang had conducted interviews for various posts and had issued appointment orders to the candidates in the category of JE, UDC, LDC etc. It is revealed that as per Section 36(4)(5)(8) of Arunachal Pradesh Municipal Act, 2007, the accused were not empowered to undertake any such process of recruitment, without government approval.
12. **WHEREAS**, the Enquiry report further revealed that all the relevant files pertaining to appointments of LDC/UDC/JE in IMC are missing and in the possession of the accused. Shri Dacha Bagang being the Municipal secretary and a member of the recruitment board has been said to be in possession of all the relevant files. There is a very high likelihood of tampering with evidences as the files are still Missing and is the most crucial document require to unearth the conspiracy. Backdated MOU was signed by Shri Dacha Bagang on behalf of IMC for training of illegally appointed candidates in furtherance of criminal conspiracy.
13. **WHEREAS**, investigation has revealed that the accused Shri Daccha Bagang along with co-accused Nitesh Kumar had gone and met the principal of Kamrup college of vocational training (for training of .139 LDC/UDCs) and Director of Rocket Science Services (for trainmg of 74 JEs) and signed Backdated MoU on behalf of Itanagar Municipal Council.

Statement u/s 164 Cr PC of Shri Devarun Bharali, Principal KCVT has revealed that the accused Shri Dacha Bagang visited him on 21st July, 2018 and requested him to sign a Backdated MoU on the pretext of official formalities dated 11th June, 2018. He further asked Principal, KCVT to liaise with co-accused Nitesh Kumar in all matters pertaining to training of these LDC/UDCs. The statement Further reveals that Nitesh Kumar paid a sum of ₹ 5 lakhs in cash -. installments as fees for training of 50 students. The Original MoU which has been seized by the SIC, bears the signatures of Shri Dacha Bagang on behalf of IMC and Nitesh Kumar as a witness, (annexed as annexure "B").

This act of Backdating of MoU and subsequent payment in cash for training of appointees shows active criminal conspiracy by Shri Dacha Bagang along with other accused. Backdating was executed by the accused persons for the reason that on 21st July, 2018, the status of the IMC was already dissolved.

14. **WHEREAS**, a similar Modus operandi has also been discovered in interaction with Shri Debendra Nath Das, Director of Rocket Science Services, where training of JEs is being conducted. As per his statement the MoU was signed by Shri Dacha Bagang on behalf of IMC and the accused Dacha Bagang requested Shri Das to backdate the MoU and appointed Nitesh as his representative, who then paid a sum of ₹ 7 lakhs 33 thousand in 2 cash installments to continue the training of illegally appointed JEs. The accused Dacha Bagang is an active member of the conspiracy as he has signed the backdated MoUs on behalf of IMC and also paid a sum of total ₹ 12 lakh 33 thousand to the training institutes through his co-accused Nitesh.

15. **WHEREAS**, Statement of Shri Debendra Nath Das was recorded u/s 161 Cr PC by the investigating agency and also U/S 164 Cr PC by the JMFC, Yupia. Sri Debendra Nath Das is the proprietor of M/S Rocket Science Services, Guwahati, franchisee of Engineers Institute of India. As per the statement of Shri Das, Nitesh is the person who had introduced Dacha Bagang with the proprietor and later on, Dacha Bagang in the capacity of the Secretary, IMC, had singed backdated MOU with the institution,
16. **WHEREAS**, Shri Nitesh has been re-examined in this regard and statement recorded u/s 161 CrPC. He had admitted all above facts and it is also stated by him that he had introduced Sri Dacha Bagang with the proprietor of RSS on the direction of Shri Olik Taring, later on, as already discussed above, Shri Dacha Bagang, in the capacity of the Secretary, IMC, had singed backdated MOU with the institution. Further, Shri Nitesh had stated that he had made payments to two institutions including RSS at Guwahati as fees etc. for the trainees (illegally appointed candidates viz JE, UDC, LDC etc.), the money being provided by Shri Olik Taring. Accordingly, the statement of Shri Nitesh has been recorded U/S 164 (5) CrPC by the JMFC, Yupia upon the order by the Special Judge, PCA, West Division, Yupia. Negative role of Shri Dacha Bagang is crystal clear from the above narration.
17. **WHEREAS**, Statement of Shri Mume Garo has been recorded in this regard. He is the FAO in the Directorate of IPR, Naharlagun and also looking after the additional charge of FAO, IMC, Naharlagun. He has no knowledge of the entire recruitment process,
18. **WHEREAS**, Statement of Shri Maley Bhowmik has been recorded in this regard. He is serving as Asstt, IMC, Naharlagun. As per him, all recruitment files should have been routed through him, as he is looking after all establishment matters but it was not done so. Pertaining to File No. 13 of the IMC office, he stated that this file pertains to business meeting and it remains in the custody of the Secretary, IMC Shri Dacha Bagang. This file along with other files are alleged to be missing.
19. **WHEREAS**, Statement of Shri Riken Riba has been recorded in this regard. He has been appointed in the capacity of Sanitary Asstt but practically he is looking after all dispatch matters and is also delivering the dak. All official out and in documents are passed through him. As per him, not a single calling letter has been dispatched officially. Hence, he is also totally ignorant about the entire recruitment process.
20. **WHEREAS**, Statement of Shri Tadar Tarang has been recorded in this regard. He was the Executive Engineer, IMC, Naharlagun. He had no knowledge of requisition placed by IMC for creation of posts and also about the entire process of recruitment.
21. **WHEREAS**, Statement of Shri T. Jerang has been recorded in this regard. He is the Administrative Officer, IMC, Naharlagun. He looks after the establishment of the IMC, Naharlagun. He was no aware of any interview conducted by the IMC for various posts.
22. **WHEREAS**, Statement of Shri Goliat Piel has been recorded in this regard. He is serving as Veterinary Doctor in IMC, Naharlagun. No information was provided to him by the IMC. Naharlagun and hence he has no idea about the entire recruitment process.
23. **WHEREAS**, Statement of the concerned staff of IMC, Naharlagun revealed that such conduct of interview by the Chairman and the members did not come to the knowledge of the staff whereas it ought to have been in the knowledge of the office staff particularly those who dealt with the establishment matter. Recruitment is a subject of establishment and there is no second opinion about it.
24. **WHEREAS**, the fact has been unearthed that interview was not conducted at all. The CDR analysis clearly substantiates the fact that the Chairman Sri Dacha Bagang and the members were at different locations on the so-called days of interview i.e. 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th June' 2018. Hence, it is established beyond reasonable doubt that the interview was totally fake.
25. **WHEREAS**, in view of the evidences deduced, it is established that the entire recruitment was fake and illegal as well. All the appointment made under Itanagar Municipal Council, Naharlagun during the incumbency of Shri Olik Taring as Chief Municipal Executive Officer and Dacha Bagang, Chairman of the interview Board is contrary to the provisions of Municipality Act. As per provisions contained under Section 36 sub-section 4 (a) (b), sub-section 5 and 8. prior approval of the State Government, is necessary for appointment of officers under Municipality whereas no approval was obtained from the State Government. Statement of Shri Sukhwinder Singh, the then Director, Town Planning had been recorded in this regard. His statement corroborates such fact Hence, the entire actions of the alleged officers and officials of the IMC, Naharlagun are commission of offences U/S 420/201/120 (B) IPC R/W Sec. 13 (2) PC Act 1988.
26. **AND WHEREAS**, from perusal of the application submitted by the investigating officer, following facts and circumstances have emerged :
 - (I) As per the provisions of Section 36 (4) (5) (8) of Arunachal Pradesh Municipal Act, 2007, the accused persons namely Smti Kipa Kaku, Shri Olik Taring, Shri Dacha Bagang and Shri Baba Bagang were not empowered to undertake any such process of recruitment, without Government approval.
 - (II) that, during the month of June, 2018, the alleged accused Shri Dacha Bagang and Shri Baba Bagang (in the capacity of Secretary, IMC and member respectively) showed the recruitment to be conducted for the post of the recruitment was illegal.

- (III) That, the other staff of the IMC office had no knowledge of the said recruitment. The establishment branch was also kept in darkness, processing the recruitment without the involvement of establishment branch, Finance and Account Officer clearly substantiates the fact of the recruitment being fake, as per the dak serving staff of IMC office, no daks pertaining to recruitment had been either dispatched by him or received by him.
- (IV) That, the MOUs with the training institutions at Guwahati were shown executed on backdate on 11th June, 2018 whereas the exact date of execution was on 21st July, 2018. The principal of both the training institutions had deposed their statement which further substantiates the fact of illegal backdating.
- (V) That, the execution of MOU was done with the help of private individual Nitesh as he was acquainted with the offices in Guwahati and the backdating was facilitated easily by him duping the principals of both the Institutions.
- (VI) From the above discussions on oral and documentary evidences, it is revealed that Smti Kipa Kaku who was the former Chief Councilor, IMC, Naharlagun, Shri Olik Taring who was the former Administrator of IMC, Naharlagun, Shri Dacha Bagang, former Asst. Town Planner cum Secretary, IMC Naharlagun and Shri Baba Bagang, former AE of IMC, Naharlagun conspired for the conduct of recruitment for the post of JEs, UDCs, LDCs, Sanitary Assistant and unskilled contingency staff though they had the knowledge that the further the recruitment IMC had already dissolved on was totally illegal as approval was not obtained for the said purpose from the competent authority. The conspiracy led to the formation of a board with Shri Olik Taring as the Chairman, Dacha Bagang as the Secretary and Sri Baba Bagang as the member. The board showed the examination and interviews to be conducted whereas the CDR data of the mobile phones shows that the chairman, member and the Secretary were at different locations on the concerned days. The examination and the interviews were so clandestine that even the Finance & Accounts Officer of the said office, Establishment Branch and the Dak Branch were kept in darkness.
27. **AND WHEREAS**, in the premises of facts and circumstances as aforesaid, it is established that the entire recruitment was fake and illegal as well. All the appointment made under Itanagar Municipal Council, Naharlagun during the incumbency of Shri Olik Taring as Chief Municipal Executive Officer and Shri Dacha Bagang, Chairman of the interview Board is contrary to the provisions of Municipality Act. As per provisions contained under Section 36 sub-section 4(a) (b), sub-section 5 and 8, prior approval of the State Govt, is necessary for appointment of officers under Municipality whereas no approval was obtained from the State Government Statement of Shri Sukhwinder Singh, the then Director, Town Planning had been recorded in this regard. His statement corroborates such fact. Hence, the entire actions of the alleged officers and officials of the IMC, Naharlagun are commission of offences U/S 420/201/120 (B) IPC R/W Sec. 13 (2) PC Act 1988.
28. **AND WHEREAS**, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, being the authority competent to remove Shri Dacha Bagang, Town Planner, the then Assistant Town Planner and Municipal Secretary, IMC, from office and after carefully examining all the facts and circumstances of the aforesaid cases and after being satisfied with the same, consider that he should be prosecuted in the Court of Law for the said offences.
29. **NOW, THEREFORE**, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, after scrutiny of FIR and relied upon documents and after proper application of mind hereby, accord sanction under the provision of Section 197 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 with Section 19 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, for prosecution of Shri Dacha Bagang, Town Planner, the then Assistant Town planner cum Municipal Secretary, IMC Naharlagun for the said offences of for any other offences punishable under the provisions of law in respect of aforesaid acts and for taking cognizance of the said offences by the Court of competent jurisdiction.

The 22nd May, 2026

No. AR-36/1/2023-SECT-1-AR/01.—In exercise of powers conferred by Section 27 of “the Arunachal Pradesh Public Examination (Measures for Prevention of Unfair Means in Recruitment) Act, 2024”, (Act No. 9 of 2024), the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to make following Rules to carry out the purpose of the Act, as follows :-

CHAPTER - I

PRELIMINARY

1. **Short title and commencement:** (1) These rules may be called “**the Arunachal Pradesh Public Examination (Measures for Prevention of Unfair Means in Recruitment) Rules, 2026**”.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette except Rule 4 and 5. Rule 4 and 5 shall come into force when the Computer Based Test (CBT) is introduced in the Recruitment Examination by the Examination Authority.
2. **Definitions :** (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires :
 - (a) “Act” means “the Arunachal Pradesh Public Examination (Measures for Prevention of Unfair Means in Recruitment) Act, 2024”, (Act No. 9 of 2024);
 - (b) “Centre Coordinator/Coordinator” means a representative of the Examination Authority deputed against each examination venue/cluster of examination venues for collection of the examination materials from the Strong Room of Examination Authority and delivering it at exam venues/District Strong Room and depositing of the same back to Examination Authority Strong Room/District Strong Room.
 - (c) “Centre Superintendent” means a representative of the Examination Authority deputed at examination centre to monitor, supervise and coordinate activities of different service providers, Examination Authority, Examination Functionaries and public servants and to ensure that the norms or standards and the guidelines notified for conduct of public examination are complied in a fair and smooth manner.
 - (d) “District Superintendent” means the Deputy Commissioner of that district or an officer-in-charge, not below the rank of Deputy Secretary to the Government, designated for a particular district, by the Examination Authority ; for coordination of activities of different service providers and Examination Authority ; and for overseeing the compliance of all norms or standards and guidelines notified for conduct of public examinations.
 - (e) “Examination Functionaries” means authorized personnel assigned for any public examination related duties by the Examination Authority/District Superintendent.
 - (f) “Guidelines” means the guidelines notified by the State Government or Examination Authority from time to time ;
 - (g) “Invigilator” means an official/officer appointed by the District Superintendent/Examination Authority against each venue as per instructions issued by the Examination Authority, for management and supervision of activities of candidates etc. during examination at their designated rooms/halls.

- (h) "Norms or standards" means set of mandatory requirements with regard to the conduct of public examinations, as notified by the State Government, from time to time ;
- (i) "Nodal Officer" means an officer in charge preferably a senior Administrative Officer of the District nominated by the District Superintendent/Examination Authority against a particular centre/venue to supervise, coordinate and manage the activities of different service providers and public servants to ensure that the norms or standards and guidelines for conduct of public examination are complied with. The Nodal officers shall also perform the duties of collection and deposit of exam materials if directed by the Examination Authority.
- (j) "Observer" means an officer, not below the rank of Deputy Secretary to the Government, designated for a particular exam venue/cluster of exam venues by Examination Authority to observe the proceedings of exam process.
- (k) "Venue-in-charge" means a person nominated by the examination conducting service provider to supervise, coordinate and manage the activities of different service providers and to ensure that the norms or standards and guidelines notified for conduct of public examination are complied with.

Words and expressions used herein but not defined and defined under any other law for the time being in force, shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in those Acts.

CHAPTER - II

ENGAGEMENT OF SERVICES OF OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES BY THE EXAMINATION AUTHORITY

3. **Engagement of services of other Government agencies by Examination Authority :** (1) When an Examination Authority engages the services of another Examination Authority for conduct of public examination, the latter Examination Authority shall not be covered under the definition of "service provider".
- (2) The schools, educational institutions and other premises owned or controlled by the central Government or State Government, Public Sector Undertakings, Autonomous Bodies and other Government Organisations shall not be covered under the definition of "service provider".
- (3) If it is establishment that the staff (including contractual staff/Contingency staff) of the institutions referred to in sub rule (2) resorts to unfair means or commits an offence, he shall be dealt with in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Act.

CHAPTER - III

COMPUTER BASED TEST

4. **Computer Based Test :** (1) The Computer Based test (CBT) includes activities, such as registration of candidates, allocation of centers, issue of admit cards, opening and distribution of question papers at examination centers, evaluation and final recommendations.
- (2) The opening and distribution of question papers, in relation to computer based test means downloading the question paper from the main server to the local server in the examination centre, as authorized by the Examination Authority, uploading and digitally transferring the question papers from the local server to individual computers authorised for the candidates in the concerned examination centers.
- (3) The Examination Authority may utilize buildings, premises, space, computers and other digital equipment available with the Central Government, State Government, Local authorities Public Sector Undertakings, Private offices or Institutions for the conduct of Computer Based Test.

CHAPTER - IV

NORMS, STANDARDS AND GUIDELINES FOR THE COMPUTER BASED TEST

5. **Preparations of norms, standards and guidelines :-** (1) The Examination Authority, on behalf of the State Government shall in consultation with the stakeholders, prepare norms, standards and guidelines for the computer based test mode of examination, which shall be notified by the State Government.
- (2) The norms, standards and guidelines shall cover physical and digital infrastructure and activities which include —
 - (a) standard operating procedure for registration of examination centres;
 - (b) space requirement within the computer based test centres;
 - (c) layout of the seating arrangement;
 - (d) specifications and layout of computer nodes;
 - (e) specifications for the server and network infrastructure;

- (f) specifications for electronic platform for conduct of computer based test;
- (g) pre-examination activities, such as pre-audit for the examination readiness of the examination centres;
- (h) candidate check in, biometric registration, security and screening;
- (i) seat allocation;
- (j) question paper setting and loading;
- (k) invigilation in the examination;
- (l) post examination activities; checklist and declarations;
- (m) guidelines for providing scribes; and
- (n) any other activities associated with conduct of public examination.

CHAPTER - V

EXAMINATION FUNCTIONARIES FOR PUBLIC EXAMINATION

6. (i) The Examination Authority may avail services of serving employees of the central Government, State Government, Public Sector Undertakings, Public Sector Banks, Government Universities, Autonomous Bodies and other Government Organizations for assigning duty as District Superintendent, Centre Superintendent, Observers, Centre Coordinator, Coordinator, Nodal Officer, Invigilator, Venue-in-Charge or for any other public examination related duties.
- (ii) The Examination Authority shall collect the information from the Deputy Commissioners/District Superintendents of the Districts for smooth conduct of recruitment examination.

CHAPTER - VI

REPORTING OF INCIDENTS OF UNFAIR MEANS OR OFFENCES

7. **Reporting of incidents of unfair means or offences:** (1) If any incident of unfair means or offence in connection with the conduct of public examination occurs, the **Centre Superintendent** shall prepare a report along with his findings in Form-1. The report in Form-1 shall be sent to the District Superintendent through Observer or Nodal Officer. If a prima facie case is made out for filing of First Information Report, the venue-in-charge/centre Superintendent shall take necessary action. The District Superintendent may review the report received and cause appropriate action to file First Information Report as stipulated in the Chapter-II (Section 3) of the Act to be investigated by police officer not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police or Assistant Commissioner of Police as specified in Section 15 of the Act.
- (2) In case, persons, below the level of Management or Board of Directors of the service providers, resort to unfair means or commit an offence or are involved in facilitating an offence, or fail to report the incidents as per section 10 of the Act, the Nodal Officer shall report the matters to the District Superintendent in Form-2. The District Superintendent shall enquire and if satisfied that representative of any service provider at examination centre level is involved, he shall direct the Nodal Officer to file the First Information Report. In case, the District Coordinator arrives at a conclusion that no First Information report is required to be filed, he shall record reasons therefor.
- (3) In case, the District Superintendent concludes that, prima facie, there is involvement of Management or Board of Directors of service provider, he shall report the details of the incident, enclosing his findings, along with Form-2 to the Examination Authority.
- (4) The cases referred in sub-rule (3) shall be referred to a committee to be constituted by the examination authority or the High Level Inquiry Committee constituted by the State Government as per Section 21 of the Act which shall examine the report of the District Superintendent and other facts and evidences and submit its finding to the Examination Authority or the State Government as the case may be for appropriate decision.
- (5) The Committee to be constituted by the Examination Authority referred to in sub-rule (4), shall comprise of a senior official from the Examination Authority, an expert member to be nominated by the Examination authority and a member from the State Government (not below the rank of Joint Secretary) and the Committee shall submit its report to the Examination Authority for appropriate decision.
- (6) In case of any incident of unfair means or offence in connection with the conduct of public examination occurs other than as specified in sub-rule (1) and (2), the Examination Authority may look into the matter and if prima facie case exist then shall file First Information Report and also constitute a committee as specified at sub-rule (5) Above to inquire into the matter immediately.
- (7) The State Government may at any time constitute a High Level Inquiry Committee as under Section 21 of the Act in case of any incident of unfair means or offence in connection with the conduct of public examination.
- (8) All incidents of unfair means or offence in connection with the conduct of public examination shall be reported to the Examination Authority by District Superintendent along with the details of action taken from time to time.

CHAPTER - VII**PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED IN RESPECT OF PUBLIC SERVANT**

8. **Procedure to be followed in Respect of Public Servant :** (1) The Examination Authority on receipt of report of District Superintendent or otherwise, regarding the actions of a public servant deputed for conduct of public examination shall examine whether anything done in conduct of public examination by the public servant was in good faith as referred to in Section 17 of the Act.
- (2) A committee may be constituted by the Examination Authority for the purpose of sub-rule (1), which shall be headed by an officer not below the rank of Secretary to the Government or equivalent and shall comprise of one senior officer from the Examination Authority and an expert to be nominated by the Examination Authority.
- (3) The Committee shall examine all relevant Information and submit its finding to the Examination Authority for appropriate action.

CHAPTER - VIII**MONITORING**

9. Every Examination Authority shall set up a mechanism for monitoring the implementation of provisions of the Act.

4. **Method of Recruitment, age limit and other qualifications :** The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, educational qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the schedule aforesaid.
5. **Disqualification :** No person :
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or
(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for the appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal Law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax :** Where the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in observing the procedure as prescribed under OM No. AR-89/2012 dated 6th March, 2013 and in consultation with the Selection Board relax any provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of person.
7. **Repeal and Saving :** The Principal Recruitment Rules for the post of Administrative Officer in the various departments of Government of Arunachal Pradesh notified vide Government Notification No. OM-12/79, dated Itanagar, the 17th December, 1982 as amended from time to time is hereby repealed. Provided that any order made or action taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been validly made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation/relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to provide for the Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh from time to time in this regard.
