No. LMD-13011/16/2026/597.—**WHEREAS**, it appears to the Governor, that a total of 34.3308 Hectares of land is required at Siyum Village, Nacho Circle, Nacho Taluk/Sub Division/Tehsil/Block, Upper Subansiri District for public purpose, Namely Siyum-Menchuka Road from Km 0.00 to Km 12.00 (Net Length 12.00 Km) by the 77 RCC (GREF) C/o 99 APO.

A total of NIL families are likely to be displaced due to the land acquisition. The reason necessitating such is given below as there is no habitat population.

The Deputy Commissioner Upper Subansiri District, Daporijo is appointed as Administrator for the purpose of Rehabilitation and Resettlement of the affected families. Therefore, it is notified that for the above said project in the Siyum Village, Nacho Circle, Nacho Taluk/Sub Division/Tehsil/Block, Upper Subansiri District a piece of land measuring 34.3308 Hectares of standard measurement, whose detailed description is as follows, is under acquisition :

This notification is made under the provisions of Section 40(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the office of the Deputy Commissioner/Collector and DLRSO on any working day during the working hours.

The Governor is pleased to authorize DC Daporijo/OC 77 RCC (GREF) and their staff to enter upon and survey land, take levels of any land, dig or bore into the sub-soil and do all other acts required for the proper execution of their work as provided and specified in Section 12 of the said Act.

Under Section 11(4) of the Act., no person shall make any transaction or cause any transaction of land i.e. sale/purchase, etc. or create any encumbrances on such land from the date of publication of such notification without prior approval of the Collector.

The provisions of sub-sections (1), (2) and sub-section (3) of Section 40 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 are applicable to the acquisition of the aforesaid land.

The provisions of Chapters -II and III and Sections 15 to 18 of the Act shall not apply to the acquisition and declaration may be made under Section 19 in respect of the above land at any time after the date of publication of the preliminary notification under sub-section (1) of Section 11;

The Collector (Deputy Commissioner), Upper Subansiri District, Arunachal Pradesh, though no award has been, may, on expiration of thirty days from the publication of the notice mentioned in Section 21, take possession of any land needed for a public purpose and such land shall thereupon vest absolutely in the Government, free from all encumbrances; and

No additional compensation will be required to be paid for acquisition of the above land.

Since the land is urgently required for the project falling within the purview of Section 40(4), it has been decided not to carry out the social impact assessment study.
