**Issued Under Section -11(1) Read with Section 40 (1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013
(INVOKING URGENCY CLAUSE)**

No. LMD-13012/2/2026/468.—**WHEREAS**, it appears to the Governor, that a total of 3.045 Hectares (30472.83 Sqm) of land is required at Sibe Village, Sibe Circle, Sibe Taluk/Sub Division/Tehsil/Block Lower Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh for public purpose, namely Construction of 2 laning with Paved Shoulder Daporijo- Dumporijo -Dollungmukh- Anand Bagan from Design Ch.35+000 to Ch 36+000 by the NHIDCL.

A total of NIL families are likely to be displaced due to the land acquisition. The Deputy Commissioner, Lower Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh is appointed as Administrator for the purpose of rehabilitation and resettlement of the affected families.

The Deputy Commissioner, Lower Siang District is appointed as Administrator for the purpose of rehabilitation and resettlement of the affected families. Therefore, it is notified that for the above said project in the Sibe Village, Sibe Circle, Sibe Taluk/Sub Division/Tehsil/Block Lower Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh a piece of land measuring 3.045 Hectares (30472.83 Sqm) of standard measurement, whose detailed description is as follows, is under aquisition:.

This notification is made under the provision of Section 40(1) of the Right to Fair compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the Office of the Deputy Commissioner/Collector and DLRSO on any working day during the working hours.

The Governor is pleased to authorize DC, Lower Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh (requiring body) NHIDCL and their staff to enter upon and survey land, take levels of any land, dig or bore into the sub-soil and do all other acts required for the proper execution of their work as provided and specified in Section 12 of the said Act.

Under Section 11(4) of the act, no person shall make any transaction of cause any transaction of land i.e sale/purchase, etc. or create any encumbrances on such land from the date of publication of such notification without prior approval of the Collector.

The provisions of sub sections (1), (2) and sub section (3) of Section 40 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 are

applicable to the acquisition of the aforesaid land.

The provisions of Chapter - II and III and Section 15 to 18 of the Act shall not apply to the acquisition and declaration may be made under Section 19 in respect of the above land at any time after the date of publication of the preliminary notification under sub section (1) under of Section 11;

The Collector (Deputy commissioner) Lower Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh, through no award has been, may, on expiration of thirty days from the publication of the notice mentioned in Section 21, take possession of any land needed for a public purpose and such land shall thereupon vest absolutely in the Government, free from all encumbrances; and

No additional compensation will be required to be paid for acquisition of the above land.

Since the land is urgently required for the project falling within the purview of Section 40(4), it has been decided not to carry out the social impact assessment study.
