THE ARUNACHAL PRADESH FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2026

AN

ORDINANCE

(No. 2 of 2026)

to amend the Arunachal Pradesh Fire and Emergency Services Act, 2026 (Act No. 12 of 2026);

WHEREAS, the Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly is not in session;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Arunachal Pradesh is **implementing the Compliance Reduction and Deregulation initiative-Phase-II in alignment with the National Reform Agenda of the Government of India**;

AND WHEREAS, as per Government of India **Deregulation** instruction, the words "National Building Code" shall not be mentioned in the State Acts;

AND WHEREAS, there is mention of the words" National Building Code" in the **Arunachal Pradesh Fire and Emergency Services Act, 2026 (Act No. 12 of 2026)**;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Arunachal Pradesh is committed to follow the Government of India **Deregulation** instruction and desires to delete the words "National Building Code" from the **Arunachal Pradesh Fire and Emergency Services Act, 2026 (Act No.12 of 2026)** ;

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (1) of Article 213 of Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to promulgate in the Seventy-Seventh year of the Republic of India, the following Ordinance, namely,-

- Short Title and Commencement:** This Ordinance may be called the Arunachal Pradesh Fire and Emergency Services (Amendment) Ordinance, 2026.
(2) It shall come into force at once.
- Amendment Section 2:** In the Arunachal Pradesh Fire and Emergency Services Act, 2026 (Act No. 12 of 2026) (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act),-
 - In clause (d) of Section 2 the words "National Building Code of India Part-IV (Fire and Safety)" appearing after the word "under" and before the word, "Oil Industry Safety Directorate Guidelines" shall be deleted.
 - Clause (s) of Section 2 shall be deleted.

3. In the Principal Act, in Section 26,-
- (i) in sub-section (1),-the words “National Building Codes of India issued by the Ministry of Urban Development” appearing after the word “of” and before the words “the Arunachal Pradesh Building Bye-laws-2019” shall be deleted.
 - (ii) in sub-section (3), the words” of National Building Codes” appearing after the word “enforcement” and before the words, “by the State “ shall be deleted.
